
Project Overview

- Develop a process that is publicly supported and prepared to apply for federal funding






Travel times from Santa Fe Intermodal Hub














Airport Corridor Study Area











Spatial mismatch between population and employment




High concentration of equity populations and high transit propensity along 10th Street




High activity levels around OKC Outlets and Walmart Supercenter



No clear terminus location in study area













Airport Corridor Population and Employment










Airport Corridor Transit Propensity

High concentration of equity populations and high transit propensity in Capitol Hill, along Interstate 44




Large employment centers at Will Rogers World Airport and FAA Complex
